REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING SCHOOL

The Board of Education of New Milford requires the following as a prerequisite for students entering the district.

1. Proof of Complete Immunizations which include:

- a) DTP/DT/Td - 4 doses with one given on or after the 4th birthday **OR**
3 doses in a child over the age of seven starting the series
- b) Tdap - 1 dose before entering Sixth Grade
- c) Polio Vaccine - 3 doses with the last dose given after the 4th birthday **OR** any 4 doses;
3 doses in a child over the age of seven starting the series
- d) Measles - 2 doses given after the 1st birthday
- e) Mumps - 1 dose after the 1st birthday
- f) Rubella - 1 dose after the 1st birthday
- g) Hepatitis B - Completed series of 3 doses; if 11-15 years of age and has not received the 3
prior doses, then should receive 2-dose Hepatitis B adolescent formulation
- h) Meningococcal - 1 dose before entering Sixth Grade
- i) Varicella - 1 dose after the 1st birthday **OR** proof of the disease
- j) HIB & PCV - Minimum 1 dose after 1st birthday for every child 12-59 months in preschool
- k) Influenza - 1 dose annually between September & December for every child 6-59 months
in preschool. If entering school after December 31 until March 31 must receive
1 dose
- l) Lead Testing - Required of all preschool children prior to entering/must be a numerical level

2. Physical Exam - Must be done prior to entering school

3. Mantoux Test - Must receive test if entering US for the first time, or transferring into NJ
Schools for a high TB incidence country

4. Emergency Card - Completed

- Failure to provide the school with this information (within 30 days from the day of entrance) may cause the student to be excluded from school until proper proof the required health information is received.
- Parent/Guardians have the responsibility of notifying the School Nurse if their child has any health problems including those which necessitate the use of medication either at home or at school.
